Its unidirectional ratcheting bezel and Sapphire Crystal with anti-reflective coating protect the dial. The steel series have a screw-down crown and case back ensuring water resistance to 200 meters and is

available on a solid-link stainless steel bracelet, black genuine leather band or gray webbing strap.
